Enterprise West Yorkshire, funded by the West Yorkshire Combined Authority offers advice and business support to anyone in the West Yorkshire region considering self-employment as a career option. There are three support packages offered and Innovative Entrepreneurs is support package 3, providing intensive and targeted support for individuals with the potential to become successful innovative entrepreneurs creating sustainable innovative businesses.

Innovative Entrepreneurs is being delivered by a 12 partner consortium, made up of partners from across the region, led by the University of Leeds.

The overarching objective for this commission is to increase the number and sustainable success of innovative entrepreneurs from underrepresented groups in the West Yorkshire region.

This programme aims to provide the support, guidance and means for individuals to transform their ideas into high impact, profitable businesses which can create positive impact within the region and beyond!

The programme will support 75 individuals over the next 2 years, with 15 participants on each cohort. The start dates of each programme will be:

Programme overview

The 9 month programme will support individuals to:

- Develop a roadmap to launch / grow their idea / start up
- Design a growth plan for how to take their idea or business to the next level
- · Develop a personal brand and entrepreneurial skill set
- Understand the investment landscape and build a bespoke investment plan
- Connect with investors
- Connect with a network of support within the region and beyond

The programme is broken down into three 12-week sections:



Part 1
Intensive Idea Development

4 x 7 hour in-person learning sessions 8 x 90-minute online learning sessions 12 hours of one-to-one coaching 6 x 1 hour group mentoring sessions



Part 2
Investor Readiness Support

10 hours of Investor readiness support 3 hours 1-1 coaching Mentoring Pitch for grant funding



Part 3
Growth Plan and next steps

3 hours of 1-1 coaching Networking events Peer support group



Co-working office space

Each participant will have access to 12 months of co-working office space through one of the Founder Hubs, located within each of the 5 districts of the region.



Access Support

This support aims to remove barriers which have traditionally prevented people from accessing this type of support, This will ensure that all people can access both the in-person and the online learning associated with the programme
